### Access to Kyoto from Yokohama

JR (Japan Railway) Shin-Yokohama to JR Kyoto Station: about 2 hours by Shinkansen (12,000-13,000 yen, one-way)

- If you travel more in Japan, Japan Rail Pass is cheaper.
